



RCP ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Resource Coordination Partnership Limited (RCP) seeks to be an environmentally friendly organisation. Employees are required to consider the impact on the environment of their decisions. Further, employees are encouraged to stipulate environmental considerations to design consultants, contractors, suppliers and business partners. All other factors being equal, employees should choose the most environmentally friendly option. RCP recognises the significance and sensitivity of the environment and is committed to actively working to achieve the following:

- 1) Protecting the environment and preventing pollution related to our activities (including that created by our suppliers and clients), and
- 2) Acknowledging sustainability issues & use of renewable resources
- 3) Complying with all applicable NZ Health, Safety and Environmental legislation, and
- 4) Continually improving our performance relating to the above.

RCP will manage our business in an environmentally responsible manner and provide leadership in our industry. To achieve this, all staff will be encouraged to be actively involved. Their involvement will be considered in personal performance reviews.

Our method to achieving the desired outcomes are:

- Regularly (at a minimum annually) assess our activities and our effects upon the environment in a systematic and logical fashion.
- Identify the actions we need to take to address each effect.
- Set targets based on the actions we need to take.
- Monitor (normally monthly) our progress on each target.

The key points of our strategy to achieve this are:

- Minimise waste by evaluating operations and ensuring they are as efficient as possible.
- Minimise emissions through the selection and use of our own travel methods and the source of our power requirements.
- Active membership of the NZ Green Building Council.
- Encouraging and actively promote reducing material use, recycling and re-using materials both internally and throughout our clients' projects.
- Meet or exceed all the environmental legislation that relates to RCP as a company and for our projects.
- Encouraging use of sustainable and durable NZ made materials.
- Encouraging the use of public transport.
- Encourage use of environmentally friendly energy sources.
- Careful review and refinement of environmental management plans on our projects. Making our construction contractors more responsible for managing the environmental aspects of our projects to the highest possible standard.
